Student Check-in

Thursday, July 23, 2015, Jester West Desk, 201 E. 21st Street, 10 a.m.-1 p.m.

Only students go through the registration line. Family members can meet students outside of Jester West Lobby.

Student Check-out

Saturday, July 25, 2015, Jester West Desk, before noon

Students must vacate their rooms and return keys before noon. A \$75 fee will be charged for any unreturned key. Students using our shuttle service should check-in at the Transportation Desk and be ready to leave 90 minutes prior to their departure time.

Parking

Limited self-pay parking is available at the Brazos Garage for up to \$18 per day; a special two-day pass allowing for all day-garage access for both colloquium check-in and check-out is available for \$20; and a special continuous three-day pass allowing for overnight parking is available for \$30. Any participant driving to campus must leave the car in the garage for the duration of colloquium. To take advantage of the special Honors Colloquium parking rate, please collect a ticket as you enter the garage. After parking your car, please take the ticket to the garage cashier office and purchase the card. Avoid parking tickets by observing all posted signs. Parking is strictly enforced.

Be Prepared

Attendees will share a room with another student (same gender) and use community bathrooms on the wings. Internet vouchers are available at check-in for \$1 (cash only). Otherwise, internet is not available in residence halls or on campus.
